Dear Monmouth Beach School Community:

The presumptive positive case of COVID-19 from January 6 has been **confirmed at this time**. We also have an additional positive case that has been confirmed in that cohort. This has no further impact to the school community as both individuals' last day in the building was Wednesday, January 6.

On Friday, January 8, we had an additional presumptive positive COVID-19 case in another cohort. This **case was found to be negative**. Students/staff in this cohort will no longer have to quarantine and will be eligible to return to in-person learning tomorrow, January 13. Members of this learning cohort will also receive a follow-up communication.

Again, if you were not contacted regarding a quarantine, your child was not considered a close contact. The Monmouth County Regional Health Commission has also been notified, and appropriate sanitizing procedures have been conducted.

Thank you for your continued support and I will update you with further information as it becomes available or changes in anyway. Our goal is to remain as transparent as possible in our communication to the community regarding situations that impact our school.
