Dear Monmouth Beach School Community:

Today we were notified of three other *presumptive positive cases of COVID-19* in the school community. Because of the elevated risk level, we are required to presume the individual is positive upon presentation of COVID-like symptoms until a laboratory test confirms otherwise.

School-related contact tracing has been completed and all close contacts have been identified and asked to quarantine. A close contact is identified as an individual who is within 6-feet for an accumulated time of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period. If you were not contacted regarding a quarantine, your child is not considered a close contact. The Monmouth County Regional Health Commission has also been notified, and appropriate sanitizing procedures will be conducted.
